WHO'S VOLUNTEERING



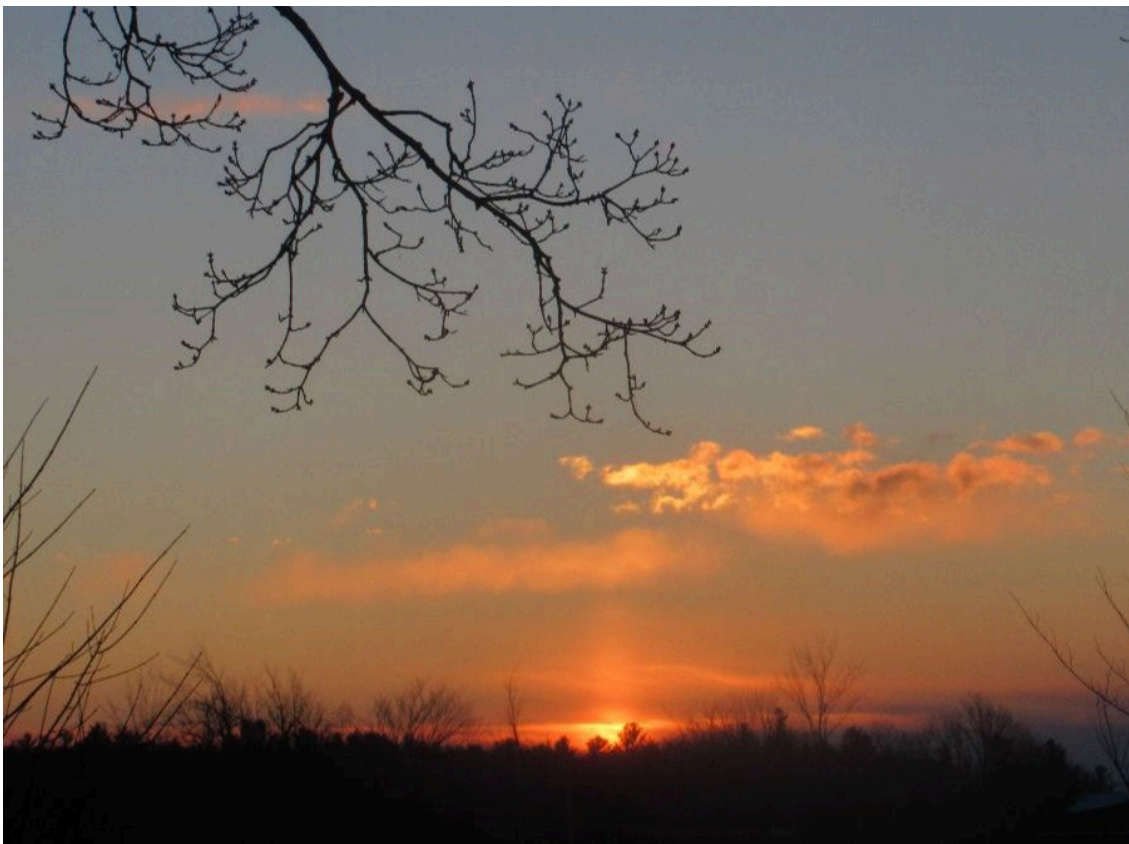
